1. Approval of July 13, 2020 Meeting Minutes – motion/David Fudge, 2nd Fred Uhe, Motion passed
2. Financial Report and Year End Review – Treasurer Michele Hayes
 - a. It was reported that NETA currently has 74 active members. Last year NETA hosted 27 “Coming Together Covid-19 Calls”, 3 calls with senators, and 1 marketing seminar for members.
3. Legislative Update – Roger Janosch
